केंद्र के मुख्य व्यवस्थापक गंग प्रसाद बतातें हैं कि अभी भी लोगो में कैंसर को लेकर जागरूकता क अभाव है। विदेशों में लोगों के कैंसर का प्राथमिक चरण में ही पत चल जाता है लेकिन भारत में लोगो को समझने में इतनी देर हो जाती है। जिस कारण मरीज की स्विति बिगड़ने लगती है। प्रति मरीज कैंसर के इंलाज में 06-30 लाख रुपरे खर्च होते हैं। साथ ही मरीजों के काउँसिलिंग की सबसे अधिक जरूरत पड़ती है। चिकित्सा के दौरान मरीजों को काउँसिलिंग करने से सकारतमक परिणाम आता है और समय रहते संबंधित रोगियों क इलाज कराने में सहयोग मिलता है।


